

Outdoor School 2011 Wednesday, May 11 – Friday, May 13

Ready or not Here we go!!! Here are a few important details.

The students' gear should be here TUESDAY, MAY 10 by 3:30 PM. It can come in before school, during school, or after school by 3:30 PM. This is so that we can load the trucks beginning first thing Wednesday morning. All the gear will need to be taken to your child's 5th grade classroom. REMEMBER NOT TO PACK WHAT STUDENTS WILL NEED FOR WEDNESDAY. BE SURE THEY HAVE A SACK LUNCH FOR WEDNESDAY!

BEDDING: All the bedding should be rolled together and placed in a garbage bag and tied shut. This can include a sleeping bag or bedroll, pillow, and a SMALL stuffed animal, if desired. The bag must be labeled (masking or duct tape) with your name and teacher. We will add colored tape to code by classroom.

GEAR: Each student may have ONE suitcase or duffel bag. Again, it should be labeled with the student name and their class.

MEDICINE: ALL student medicine, including vitamins, must be checked in through the office no later than **Monday**, **May 9**. Students will not be allowed to keep any medicine in their cabins/rooms. Adults must also check in their medicines at the camp infirmary unless they keep it in a locked container. **ALL MEDICINES MUST BE IN THEIR ORIGINAL CONTAINER OR A DOCTOR'S ORDERS WILL BE REQUIRED**. **THIS CAN CAUSE UNNECESSARY DELAYS ON WEDNESDAY MORNING**. We also need a filled out and signed **STUDENT HEALTH INFORMATION** form for all students and chaperones by May 9.

SNACKS? TOYS? MONEY? - Please remember that snacks and/or electronic toys (including cell phones, ipods, walkmen or radios) and/or money must not be sent with the students. If found it will be confiscated until the end of the school year.

LUNCH ON WEDNESDAY: Everyone, including adults, needs to have a disposable lunch for Wednesday. These can be purchased through our cafeteria by returning the bottom part of this page on or before Friday, May 6.

BACKPACKS: On Wednesday, all students should have only their backpacks and a coat with them. In the backpack should be their lunch, study book, pencils, and a poncho. (Optional: cards, paper, book) They should be dressed ready for whatever Oregon weather we may encounter and wearing sturdy shoes. They will not have the rest of their GEAR until approximately 5:00 that afternoon, AFTER we have been to the Pacific City tide pools (brrrr), sand dunes (BIG dune), lunch and the Tillamook Cheese Factory.

DEPARTURE TIME: If parents who are attending Outdoor School bring in their gear on Tuesday, May 10 they can arrive by 8:30 AM on Wednesday, May 11 or bring it with them on Wednesday and arrive by 9:00 AM to help load gear into the truck. Students arrive at their normal time. We will all be leaving as soon as we can after all busses have arrived. **PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE ON THIS DAY. WE CANNOT WAIT FOR STRAGGLERS.**

RETURNING TIME!!! We will be getting back to the school around 3 PM on Friday. Please be sure to have arrangements made for your child's prompt pick-up. Do not rely on bus transportation in case we are delayed and return after 3:10 PM.

ATTENDING PARENTS— If you have not already done so, you will need to fill out a Criminal Background check form and turn it into the Newberg School District Office. At that time you will have your picture taken for a badge. You must have this process completed in order to attend.
