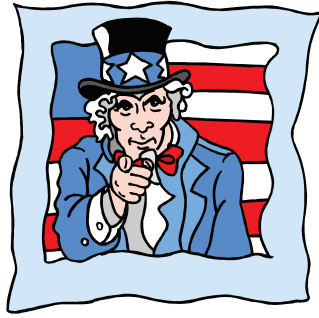


The PTO Needs You!

Further, the coordinators need support from involved parents to make these events happen!

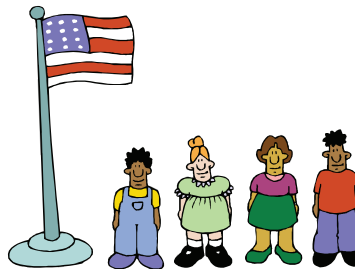


Got some time? Got some skills?
