New Ideas

- Mixed-use space at Edwards ES (e.g. cafeteria, use by other organizations) / cafeteria/gym hybrid (x4).
- Replace Edwards cafeteria and District Office with combo space / community + clinic partnerships.
- Improve design of pick-up/drop-off at Edwards ES.
- Make Dundee at K-8 school.
- Combine Dundee and Ewing Young.
- Close Ewing Young; move District Office to Ewing Young.
- NHS needs HVAC overhaul, not band-aids (x3).
- Districtwide HVAC.
- Multi-use sports complex at Renne.
- Gym / MPR facility at NHS.
- PE facilities (outdoor) at both middle schools.
- Gym and weight room replacement at NHS, including higher ceilings.
- Upgrade/maintenance of NHS fields.
- Synthetic turf multipurpose fields.
- Turf fields at MVMS and CVMS to accommodate year-round use.
 Increase covered areas at elementary and middle schools.
- Dual language spaces at MVMS and NHS.
- · Wellness / mental health spaces (e.g. deregulating stations or wellness rooms/centers) (x3).
- Spaces dedicated to smaller support functions (i.e. resource room, mindfulness room).
- Teen parent support.
- Connect all or many buildings at NHS (for safety).
- Immediate occupancy for all gyms (seismic).
- Power generators and other resiliency options.
- CTE spaces for younger students and/or at MS level (x2).
- Working drain at MVMS, High Tech greenhouse (cannot fully use without it!).
- Complete replacement of J/H CTE building at NHS.
- MS support at Catalyst/Springbrook.
- COLA/hybrid expansion at Springbrook.
- Rethink MS model K-8? K-6? 3-6 and 7-8?

Potential Project Options: Edwards ES

Edwards Elementary School

- Construct new cafeteria/multipurpose room.
- Construct classroom addition and community space.
- Relocate District Office to Edwards Elementary.
- Modernization to existing facility.
- Pick-up/drop-off lane reconfiguration.







Potential Project Options: Dundee ES

Dundee Elementary School

- Replace current Dundee facility with a new 350student elementary school.
- Replace current Dundee facility with a new 550student K-8 school.







Potential Project Options: Catalyst

Expansion of Catalyst High School Program.









Potential Project Options: PE/Athletics

PE/Athletic Upgrades

- P.E. facilities improvements at Newberg High School.
- Replacement of turf football field at Newberg High School.
- Construction of covered play structures at four (4) elementary schools.
- Construction of covered play structures at both middle schools.
- P.E. facilities improvements at one (1) middle school.
- New synthetic turf field at MVMS.
- New synthetic turf field at CVMS.







Potential Project Options: STEM/CTE

STEM/CTE Upgrades

- Science lab upgrades at Newberg High School.
- CTE/STEM improvements at Newberg High School.
- Greenhouse classroom at Newberg High School.
- CTE/STEM improvements at middle and elementary schools.





Potential Project Options: Maintenance

Maintenance Improvements

- \$16.5 M out of \$61 Million.
- \$20 M out of \$61 Million.









Potential Project Options: District-wide Upgrades

District-Wide Upgrades

- Security vestibule at every school.
- Kitchen equipment upgrades.
- Technology upgrades.
- Generator added at every school and District Office building.
- Expansion of dual language program.
- Early childhood education enhancements.
- 21st Century learning upgrades.
- Resiliency upgrades to new construction.
- Special education enhancements.
