The purpose of this memo is to provide a reminder to building central office staff of the special education child find obligation under state and federal law. General evaluation and reevaluation guidelines per state and federal guidelines are that the evaluation is completed and eligibility is determined within 60 days of signed consent.

OAR 581-015-2110

General Evaluation and Reevaluation Procedures

- (5) Evaluation timelines:
- (a) Initial. An initial evaluation must be completed within 60 school days from written parent consent to the date of the meeting to consider eligibility.
- (b) Reevaluation. A reevaluation must be completed within 60 school days from written parent consent (or from the date the evaluation is initiated under OAR 581-015-2095(3)(c)) to the date of the meeting to consider eligibility, continuing eligibility or the student's educational needs.

As part of the District Special Education Performance and Review and Improvement Process, a procedure for special education staff has been created and is attached to this memo for your convenience. Due to the complexity of special education law and requirements, it is <u>required</u> that a special education case manager complete all consents for special education evaluation following standard District process and procedures which include a review of records, parent input and determination of special education referral.
