- Roll call taken.
- Reviewed and approved minutes from November 17, 2022 Meeting.
- Work Related Injuries reviewed.
- Student Incident Reports reviewed.
- Safety Drills Report reviewed.
 - We are almost half way through the year. Tomorrow is a good weather day so if a drill is needed that may be a good time. Reminder two Earthquake and two Lockdown drills each year. One in the fall and one in the spring.
 - Tracy Lozada mentioned that the Admin. Bldg. needs to have their drills. New staff will need a person on point to manage. Larry Hampton will talk to Admin. Staff.
- Safety Work Orders reviewed.
 - No new Safety Work Orders.
- New Business:
 - Dale Seachord reported that NHS Custodians are having issues with back problems. There are videos available to teach proper lifting, however; Dale still sees staff lifting improperly. Custodians do lift heavy weight. Larry Hampton mentioned that he noticed at some of the construction sites the crews all do stretching exercises at the beginning of the shift and discuss any concerns. Crews should take a couple of minutes to stretch and discuss any hazards. Dale said that some staff have had injuries that could have been prevented. Larry will look into some possibilities for stretching basics.

- Larry reminded staff that every building except Dundee would have some kind of construction this summer. This is not completely a safety concern but there are safety concerns that go along with that. Everyone be careful and be aware in working around construction.

Summer school will mostly be at Antonia Crater and CVMS this next summer because they are having the least amount of work done. Most will be at Crater

and a few grade levels at CVMS.

Annie Berger asked if fixing roofs is part of the Bond? The plan is to re-roof Ewing Young and Mabel Rush with Bond money. Not enough money to reroof every school that has issues.

- Annie Berger asked where the new Dundee Elementary would be located. It is on the SE side of town backed up to the bypass. More students will be able to walk

to school at the new site.

- Annie Berger asked if we currently have custodial openings? Or are we fully staffed? Larry reported that we are currently filling a part time position at

MVMS, but all other positions are filled.

Rachele Lane reported that there is a carpet at an exit door to the playground. If there is a rock or pebble under the mat, you cannot exit the door. Walk off mats should be inside. Larry is not sure why we would have a mat on the outside. Rachele would like a policy to not have outside mats. The carpet should not be outside. If it is out there, it should be moved far enough out to not block the door.

Rachele Lane reported that when carpet was removed during the remodel at Antonia Crater, many doorframes were nicked and there are metal pieces at floor level. Some have sharp pieces. Would this be Contractor or work order for Maintenance. Larry said put in a work order to address the issue and we can look

at how to go forward.

Rachele Lane reported that outside lighting on the parking lot side at Antonia Crater is pretty gloomy from the first parking lot to front door. Not enough lighting from car to curb. Rachele has work orders in for outside lighting. These

are burned out lights. Several work orders have been put in for this.

- Rachele Lane asked if black top lighting could be turned on. When doing early morning work it is very dark. Rachele said additional lighting was added, but not sure how to turn them on. Larry will follow up with Steve Owen from Northside Electric. At some schools, there are override switches. CVMS and MVMS have override switches. Bob said when you turn those on they stay on and you have to remember to turn them off.

- Rachele Lane asked if new controls could be added for the chiller area. This area is not secured and controls for chiller tower are accessible to students. Students throw balls in that area. At the chiller tower where it is all fenced in, chiller controls are accessible to anyone if you are inside the fence. Kids are climbing the fence and getting in there. Annie Berger asked if they would get shocked. Rachele Lane said they could get hurt with anything in there.

Bob Harding reported that the new drinking fountain needs a filter. Larry said this has been done. Bob said that it is not working properly. Larry and Principal Jennifer Bailey checked yesterday and it all worked fine. Larry is having a new

drinking fountain with bottle filler installed in the gym at MVMS.

- Dale Seachord asked about the auto scrubber taken for repair. The gym floors are getting dirtier and dirtier. The machine is at the Physical Plant. Repairperson from Home Depot stopped and looked at it and has not got back to us. Larry reported that with new construction some schools would get new equipment. Like at Antonia Crater where we have all hard floors instead of carpet, they will get new bigger equipment.

Bob Harding asked about getting certificates for the lift training that was done a few months ago. The training that was done was more of a demonstration because the staff doing the demonstration were not forklift certified and cannot

provide certification.

- Tracy Lozada mentioned adding a Principal to Safety Committee. Larry will put it out to the Principals to see who should be assigned.

• The next Safety Committee Meeting will be February 16, 2023.
