Roll call taken.

• Reviewed and approved minutes from February 16, 2023 Meeting.

- Safety Committee did not meet in March 2023. Quarterly Safety Inspections were completed in March, with the exceptions of the Administration Building and the Edwards Portable. Custodian did not complete these as of yet. The annual Asbestos publication was placed with Pamplin Media and copies were distributed district wide to be posted and filed in AHERA books.
- Brett Royer will be taking over as Chairman of Safety Committee and will be looking at ways to streamline meetings. Brett will discuss ideas with members.
- Work Related Injuries reviewed.
 - Discussed work related injuries. March has been a crazy month for weather. Watch for slippery and frosty steps and entryways.
- Student Incident Reports reviewed.
 - March and April had more accidents reported. Quite a few playground injuries reported. Lacerations and fractures.
- Safety Drills Report reviewed.
 - Received Edwards ES March drill this morning. Still need Lockdown and Earthquake drills done before the end of the year. Newberg High School drill was done yesterday. Notes show February drill done in March. Tracy will correct.
 - Need to discuss drills at the Admin. Building. These have not been done for a couple of years. Brett will follow up with Admin. Staff to see who will be in charge of this as there a lot of new staff in that building.

Safety Work Orders reviewed.

- No safety work orders.

New Business:

- Bob Harding has a light out in the back at Mountain View that needs to be replaced. May need the bucket truck. Electrician from Northside is only here one day a week now. Bob was asked to put in a work order. Lori Britton also has two lights out at Joan Austin, one at the front entrance and one in the service driveway. Jennifer Marshall also has lights out at Mabel Rush, inside and outside, but are not safety related. Antonia Crater also has lights out. Work Orders have been in for one to two years now at Mabel and Crater.
- Brett asked how things are at Dundee and Tim Wright reported that everything is good.
- Brett let everyone know that there will be construction at most schools this summer and he will be going around to see how things are going and give a hand where needed.
- Brett is continuing to look for lifting training videos. He will compile a list and share with custodians. These will most likely come from UTube.
- Annie Berger reported that the two new AED units arrived, and are in place. The Physical Plant now has one and she replaced the one needed at NHS. The Physical Plant purchased these two units. Apparently, the District Office ordered eleven units in September 2022, but have not received yet. Annie does not know who these were ordered from. Brett will reach out to Tabitha Renne, Superintendent's Assistant, and check.
- Rachele Lane asked about a FURPA confidentiality policy. She reported that teachers and counselors are disposing of student records in the garbage. Rachele will send a detailed email to Brett and he will follow up on this.
- Dale Seachord asked about heating at NHS. Consistently have problems with two of the master boilers going into fault mode and he has to reset. Dale found out today that whenever we have a fire alarm that goes off, the boilers also shut off. This has been an ongoing problem for years. Someone has to reset boilers for part of the buildings. Over the last two weeks we have one hallway that feels like the air conditioning is on. Dale has sent emails to Phillip Huntington, HVAC Technician, but has not received any answer. The boiler upstairs is disassembled and has been for over a year now. The boiler, including the hood is in pieces and is laying in the hallway. Brett will stop by to look, and asked Dale to please send another email to Phillip Huntington and Larry Hampton. Send a copy of the email to Brett. If the boiler is not working properly toxic fumes will not be vented out of the building.

- (Update: Brett Royer contacted Larry Hampton about the boiler and Larry added the following notes: It is not the hoods that are off in the boilers it is the covers. Parts are not in any hallways where staff or students would be. With the Bond, we will be adding two new bigger boilers to replace the 2 main boilers that we have now. The boiler Dale is talking about is one of the smaller boilers that would kick on if the two main boilers needed help in heating but these smaller boilers have reached the end of their life and will not be repaired. The problem with Bldg. E being cold Contractor, Heinz Mechanical found a programming issue that has now been fixed.)
- Rachele Lane reported that water is not going through the drain but over the drain at the lock top area of new construction. Brett Royer made note of this.
- Brett Royer reported that he had a meeting yesterday about panic buttons in schools. Every school, except NHS, will have panic buttons. The work started yesterday on procedure and policy as to what the panic buttons are to be used for, how to use, and when to use. The panic button, when you hit it, is for an immediate threat and danger to life. These are not for an angry parent who may be irate, but not threatening. When you hit the button, Police are going to come full blazing in body armor, with guns, ready for anything. The button will be at the front entrance at each school. There will be two buttons, one is a panic button and one is a lockdown button. Work on this will continue over the summer, will be complete and implemented next school year, and will be given to everyone. The panic buttons are disconnected right now. Brett met with Officer Moreland yesterday and did a test at CVMS to make sure everything is disconnected, and they were.
- Brett Royer reported another safety issue at Antonia Crater about the Sport Court. Pieces were separating, and this has been corrected. The PE teacher went out and set all pieces back in place so it is fine now and will be safe through the rest of this school year. Please let Brett know if you see any issues like this at any schools.
- Brett will be doing more work on Risk Management issues over the next few months
- Bob Harding is retiring after 34 years with the Newberg School District. Congratulations to Bob! David Budahl is also retiring in the next month or so from Newberg High School. Both of these positions will be filled before the 2023-2024 school year.
- Rebecca Brenner, Fiscal Services Assistant and Purchasing Specialist, joined the meeting today. Rebecca works with our insurance agent on areas of safety. Rebecca wanted to let everyone know that we will be renewing our insurance policies and she is reviewing and updating schedules of what assets we have at our schools and what is insured. Rebecca will talk more to Admin. about this, but be thinking about your buildings and sites and see what has changed over the past few years and what items have gone away. She will provide a list of what we have had and may ask for this Committee's help in updating. She will be working on this in May 2023.

- Due to construction, we will be closing most schools over the summer for any activities. Each school will place closures in SchoolDude so that outside groups cannot rent facilities. CPRD Care will be at Dundee this summer and will probably be the only school available for use.
- The next Safety Committee Meeting will be May 18, 2023.
- Meeting was adjourned.
