• Roll call taken.

• Reviewed and approved minutes from January 20, 2022 Meeting.

- Annie Berger asked about the number of staff injuries at the High School. Larry Hampton wondered if the school is feeling like being more vigilant about reporting. Many of the reports were for incidents that happened and not really injuries. Maybe our report is being used for other reporting purposes. Annie asked if there is a better system for documenting or reporting incidents. Larry said that incidents should go through Special Ed programs so they can address issues and staffing. Larry will let Ann Ziehl know that we are seeing quite a few of these reports and maybe she can address with staff. We want them to report when someone is injured only, whether it be students or staff.
- Work Related Injuries reviewed.
 - Again, a good number of these incidents are behavioral incidents and not necessarily injuries. What we report here are more accident type things involving equipment or school safety. Things that we can address and correct.
 - A person at CVMS fell from a six-foot ladder. Brian Curio thinks it was another custodian at the school.
- Student Incident Reports reviewed.
 - Short list this month. Annie Berger said things have been slower this year and not as many injuries.

Safety Drills Report reviewed.

- February drills have not been reported so far this month. Month is half over so remind staff to have drills. As we get into spring, have one Lockdown and one Earthquake drill planned. With Covid some of the drills many not have been done as much but as we get into March plan drills.

• Safety Work Orders reviewed.

- No new Safety Work Orders.

• New Business:

- Effective April 1, 2022 will no longer be required in our schools.

Larry Hampton reported that at another District Safety meeting it was announced that we can open up drinking fountains. Make sure we are cleaning and sanitizing twice a day. Once in the morning and once later in the day. Jennifer Marshall said that her Principal had her close the drinking fountains off again.

With mask mandate going away March 31, 2022, Tim Lauer, Principal at Mabel Rush, expressed concerns about the Life Skills and vulnerable students. He wants a requirement in place so that staff continue wearing masks while working with these students. This concern has been sent to Superintendent Novotney. This is something that can be determined program by program. It is possible that we could have an upswing in Covid cases with masks going away. Will need to look at different situations. We are not requiring masks, but staff can wear them if they want to. Everyone will have a choice, both students and staff. We currently have had some restrictions on field trips, overnight trips, virtual meetings, etc. The District has said that as of April 1, 2022 that will open up as well. Annie Berger said Ann Ziehl will check with Dr. Novatney to see if staff will be required to wear masks around medically vulnerable students. We do not know yet. Annie Berger advised that the District does have tests and staff can take one home if you feel like you may have Covid. You can get a test from school offices and go home to take. When masks go away quarantine rules will change. We are currently only quarantining students that are three feet away. When masks go away that will change to six feet. This will more than likely mean more quarantined students and staff. Continue to view our distancing. Larry Hampton suggested and Annie Berger seconded that we should continuing having this meeting virtually. It is more beneficial.

- Annie Berger has a new co-worker. Nurse Kate, from Texas. Kate has been a school nurse in Texas for six years and comes to us with lots of experience. She's worked with Annie over the last week and a half and has caught on really fast. Annie will continue attending Safety meetings for now. Kate is a good hire and Annie is looking forward to working with her. Kate will be based at Crater. Annie is at the High School and will continue to work with the High School, Mabel Rush, Mountain View and Springbrook. Kate will take all grade schools except Mabel Rush and she will work with CVMS. Can still call Annie if Kate

cannot be reached and vice versa.

- Rachele Lane forwarded info regarding requirements for flushing water before using drinking fountains. There is a state requirement. Larry will review and share information. Rachele asked that this be added to custodial schedules so they know when to flush and that it is a state requirement. The Custodial Leads at each school should handle any revision to duty schedules.
- Bob Harding asked who is responsible for changing filters on bottle fillers at drinking fountains? Larry Hampton said he thinks that Audie Cooper in Maintenance handles this. Put in a Work Order and he will take care of it.
- With Bond constructions projects starting this summer, we will need to watch for safety issues. The Construction companies also have safety measures and requirements in place, but we will need to be vigilant and report any issues to Larry Hampton. Rachele asked if a timeline would be provided of the work from the construction companies. Larry said that bids for Crater and Chehalem Valley will be opened this week so we will know in a few days. Once we have contractors on board we can work on coordination of jobs to see how, or if, that will interfere with our own work schedules. We will be able to coordinate. Rachele noted that Jump Start Kindergarten is at Crater this summer. Larry said it may not happen at Crater. Construction companies have an end date of August 22, 2022 that they will be shooting for. And a definite end date by the following week when staff are back. Have not discussed Jump Start specifically at the District but Larry will ask. Larry has communicated with CPRD that they will not be able to use some areas. If they use fields at CVMS and Crater they will not have access to the parking lots. They have known this for more than a year. There will be a lot more information coming out as we get closer to June.
- The next Safety Committee Meeting will be March 17, 2022.
- Meeting was adjourned.
