2012 Crystal Apple Awards

The Crystal Apple Awards recognizes Newberg Public School employees for exceptional service to education.

Nominating an Employee

Students, parents, community members and Newberg School District employees are encouraged to nominate any district employee for this award. The nominee must be currently employed full or part time by the Newberg School District. The nominee must have worked for the district for at **least three years** prior to the current school year. Instructions

 - a. How does the nominee contribute to the goals of the Newberg School District?
 - achieve high academic standards and attain continuous improvement in student achievement.
 - enhance student learning and development through the arts, professional and technical opportunities, and other enrichment experiences.
 - protect the public's investment by planning and budgeting for cyclical and preventative maintenance of all district facilities.
 - b. How does the nominee impact students, their school or the school district?

Nomination Categories

Teacher

- Three awards will be given: one for an outstanding elementary teacher (K-5), middle school teacher (6-8) and high school teacher (9-12).
- Regular or special education teachers for all grades and licensed, non-classroom specialists, including counselors, are eligible for this award.

Administrator/Supervisor/Professional-Technical

- This category includes school and district administrators, supervisors and professional-technical personnel.
- This award is given every other year and will be awarded in odd-numbered years.

Support Staff

- There are two awards in this category. One recognizes instructional support staff, such as educational assistants and other classified staff directly involved in supporting student instruction.
- The second category is for classified/confidential staff in a non-instruction capacity, such as food service, grounds, maintenance, custodial or clerical support.

Selection Process

Nominations must be received by May 25, 2012 and will be reviewed by a selection committee consisting of parents, students, a school board member, business representative, a retired educator and administrator. Award recipients will be honored at the Newberg Public Schools Crystal Apple Awards program on June 11, 2012.
