Dundee Elementary School received an overall state rating of Level 4 on a five-level scale. This means our students in grades 3-5 performed above average on standards-based assessments last year in reading and math.

Our teachers support our students in a variety of strategies so that a significant percentage of students met or exceeded the standards in reading and math:

- 84% met/exceeded state standards for reading
- 77% met/exceeded state standards for math






