Dear Parents and Community Members,

Our annual Oregon School Report Card communicates the results from the Smarter Balanced assessment our students took last spring. The purpose of the assessment is to measure how well our students are mastering the Common Core State Standards, which Oregon adopted to insure student are prepared for college and the workplace. Instead of asking students to answer multiple-choice questions about what they have or have not learned at the end of the year, this assessment requires students to explain their reasoning, demonstrate critical thinking, writing and problem solving.

The results of the Smarter Balanced assessments along with students' class work, district progress monitoring assessments and classroom observations combine to help students, teachers and parents understand more about their strengths and areas for growth. Results showed the need for continued urgency to provide all our students the support and access they deserve to reach their highest potential.

Many factors come together to create student success. I am proud of the effort each of our students made on the test and the growth our school had this last year. I also appreciate the work that schools and families did to support our students in demonstrating what they have learned. If your child took the tests in grades 3-5 last spring, I know you are eager to see how he or she did. Those results along with other student work will be shared at parent-teacher conferences in October.

We look forward to working with you and your student.


