This is made possible by a partnership between Newberg FISH, Yamhill Community Action Partnership (YCAP), and local community support. Newberg FISH understands that hunger, nutrition, and healthy eating are directly connected a child's ability to learn and have success in the classroom.

Each week, participating children and/or parents may pick up a bag of food filled with a balanced, nutritious meal for a family of four. Families with 5 or more members may receive two bags to ensure enough food for everyone residing in the home. Food bags will be available at the end of the school day on Fridays (or the last day of school for the week) at the designated locations. Participation in this program is confidential.

- TANF or SNAP enrollment
- Household income at/or below listed incomes or
- Referred to the program by school staff
