What is PBIS? Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports is a behavior system that promotes a positive school climate and fosters being respectful, responsible, safe and ready to learn. Students are taught what it means to be safe, responsible and respectful in all areas at school and then they are rewarded for demonstrating positive behaviors. Many parents have found that when they use the same behavior expectations language as their school, it is easier for children to make good choices at home. Research shows that when the home and school work together, student learning is more successful.
