Dear Parents/Guardians of Mountain View Middle School 7th grade students:

Newberg School District will be delivering the My Future-My Choice curriculum in the 7th grade in order to align with state requirements. My Future-My Choice is a skills-based, comprehensive, age-appropriate, and medically accurate sexual health education program. My Future-My Choice is designed to help students recognize the pressures and the consequences of early sexual involvement and encourages students to make healthy choices for themselves. Students also learn about puberty, healthy relationships, assertive communication, healthy decision making, and consent.

The Oregon Health Education Standards (revised December 2016) and House Bill 2509 requires age-appropriate, comprehensive sexual health education be taught once a year in middle school.
