Code of Conduct

- Only middle school students are allowed; student ID is required to enter or in-person parental permission. Parent must sign child in with chaperone.
- Students are not allowed to leave until the dance is over at 9pm. The only exceptions made are when a student is released to a parent.

- No backpacks or purses are allowed.

- Middle School dances follow the same dress code as the Newberg School District. This includes inappropriate dress, inappropriate sayings on shirts, bandanas, etc.
- No inappropriate physical behavior. This includes piggyback riding, rough housing, moshing, "party boy-ing", bullying or intimidating.
- No refunds offered to anyone who has been removed due to breaking the rules.
- Chaperones reserve the right to not allow in, or remove anyone, who is not in compliance with the rules.
- In the case of any Code of Conduct violations that lead to the dismissal from the event, the parent is called to pick up the student.
