# Changes are afoot

#### Longer school day....

This year both Mtn. View and Chehalem Valley Middle Schools will be extending their school days. School hours from the first through last day of school are 7:40 am (with the warning bell ringing at 7:35) to 2:45 pm. There is an exception...Wednesdays in the Newberg School District are called Late Start Wednesdays. School hours are 8:40 am to 2:45 pm.

Students enter the building through the Commons door beginning at 7:15 am (8:15 am on Wednesdays – if you need to drop off your student prior to 8:15 am, a study hall is provided beginning at 7:15 am).

#### New Schedule...

This year Mtn. View will have a seven period day with three ½ hour lunch times. We rotate lunches every 12 weeks or so which allows everyone to experience 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> lunch times.

If you would like exact times of our periods, the bell schedule will be posted on Mtn. View's website under the Parent Resources tab, then Bell Schedule.

The office is open Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 4:00 pm.

#### What to bring:

- Yourselves and your student!
- •Completed Student Profile this is also known as the Emergency Contact Form (enclosed in this mailing). This is your "ticket" into the event! Before you come please make any necessary changes to this form. Email is a very big communication tool at Mtn. View. Please be sure your email is up-to-date or added to the Student Profile.
- Completed Receipt (enclosed in this mailing)-To help make the fee lines move faster, please complete the enclosed receipt and have your cash, check (payable to MVMS), or credit card ready.

These evenings take the place of Back to School Night and we strongly encourage you to bring your student with you. We ask that all students be accompanied by an adult.

If you have a 6<sup>th</sup> grader and a 7<sup>th</sup> or 8<sup>th</sup> grader, we encourage you to attend the August 27 event. Schedules and locker assignments will <u>not</u> be available for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders prior to the August 27 event.

The first step during this event is to turn in your completed Student Profile and receive a "passport" that will guide you through various stations in our Gym. Be sure to get a stamp showing you've visited each area!

<u>Fees</u> - Fees can be paid by cash or check made out to MVMS or Visa, Master Card, American Express or Discover. Debit card with Visa or Master Card logo (no debit cards that require a PIN).

Fees to pay that night:

- \*PE Uniform (required for 6th Graders and any 7th and 8th Graders in need of a new uniform) \$15
- \*PE Sweats (optional) \$23 Set; sweat pants \$12; sweatshirt \$11
- \*Yearbook (optional) \$20

7th & 8th Graders may have the following fees as well as the fees listed above:

- \*Art/Science Discovery (if you are enrolled in the class) \$15
- \*8th Grade Celebration T-shirt (required) \$10

<u>PE Uniforms</u> are shorts and a shirt. The same uniform is mandatory at both Newberg middle schools and the high school, which will enable you to use it for many years! After you've paid for the PE Uniform, stop by the PE Station to pick it up and you'll be ready for school!

<u>PE Sweats</u> - If your student decides to wear sweats in addition to their uniform, these are the ones they'll need to wear. Pay for them at the Fee Station and pick them up at the PE Station.

<u>Yearbook</u> - Yearbooks are distributed the second to last day of school.

8th Grade Celebration T-shirts - All 8th Graders who attend the 8th Grade Celebration on the last day of school, will be wearing these awesome shirts...pay now or pay by March 1.

<u>Lunch Money</u> (pay with separate check) Stop in the Commons to deposit lunch money in your child's account and they'll be ready for the first day. This year's middle school prices are: \$1.50 for breakfast and \$2.85 for lunch. If you are applying for free and reduced lunches, please remember an application must be completed every year. You can also put lunch money on your student's account via the internet at myschoolbucks.com for a small fee.

Mtn. View Parent Group - The parent group meets the second Wednesday of every month at 1 pm.

Throughout the school year there are a variety of volunteer opportunities at Mtn. View and these folks have the information. We truly appreciate you and your volunteer time!

Schedule and Locker Assignment -This last station is where your student will receive their schedule and locker assignment. Walk through their schedule with them and practice opening their locker! If your student desires to personalize the inside of their locker, only magnets or reusable adhesive products are to be used. Please do not use any type of tape or attach stickers as they cause damage to the locker finish.

<u>School Supplies</u> - There will be places to drop off computer paper, glue sticks, 3x5 note (index) cards and tissue. The first day of school the locker bays are busy! Take the opportunity to have your student set up their locker during these events and leaving their school supplies in their locker.

If your student rides the bus, the bus they ride will be for middle and high school students only. The bus arrives much earlier in the morning as well as getting home earlier in the afternoon. September 3 – Picture Day Picture packets will be sent home the first day of school. All students will have their picture taken, at no charge, for their Student ID card and Mtn. View's Yearbook.

June 11 is our 8th Grade Celebration Students report to school like any other school day and will be attired in their 8th Grade Celebration T-shirts which they will receive the day of the Celebration. The shirts cost \$10 and can be paid for during the 7th & 8th Grade Ice Cream Social on August 28 or prior to March 1. Seating is available for Parents and Grandparents who would like to attend this event. Parking is available in the MVMS lot, NHS Tennis Court lot or on the street.

If you are aware of middle school students who have moved into the MVMS boundary, please pass onto their parents that new student registration begins on August 20 from 8:00 am - 2:30 pm. It is very helpful if they have the name and address of their previous school and current immunization records. Students will be given a math and reading test during this time.
