



Advanced Placement Contract 2023-2024 Academic Year

AP courses are considered college level courses, in which students can earn an additional 1.0 weighted value grade point for each AP course they complete. In addition, students have the potential of earning college credit by taking and passing the exam with a three (3) or better. Students should expect one to two hours of home study for every hour spent in class. Successful completion of the course will prepare students for the AP exam in the corresponding subject. For most students, there is an adjustment period in the beginning of the course, however, most students adjust to the rigor and learn to perform at a satisfactory level or above.

By initialing below, I understand the requirements of enrolling in this/these Advanced Placement Course (s); and my parents/guardian and I agree to the following terms:

- 1. The demands of an AP course exceed those of a general college prep courses, and I am committed to the extra effort needed to succeed in each course.
2. I understand that an AP course is a yearlong commitment and it is an expectation that I will not withdraw from this AP course at the end of the first semester.
3. I understand that I must abide by the conditions set forth in the course syllabus (e.g., attendance, grading and make-up policies)
4. After reading the course descriptions/syllabus for each AP course, I am confident that I have the skills and dedication necessary to be successful in the course listed below.
5. Registration for the AP exam is done through College Board and students will receive the "Join Code" from their AP teacher. It is the students responsibility to register for each AP course.
6. The cost of each AP exam is \$144 (AP Studio Art 2D & 3D are TBD). This fee will be charged to their student account and needs to be paid prior to taking the exams in May. Assistance is available to those that qualify. Please see the Bookkeeper with questions.
7. AP exams will now be ordered no later than November 15th. Any student who withdraws from the AP course or chooses not to take the exam AFTER November 1st will be required to pay the \$40 late cancellation/unused exam fee (per exam).
8. Students who do not register for the exam prior to November 1st will incur an additional \$40 late registration fee (per exam).
9. All AP students who commit and register to take the AP exam offered in May agree that if they are a no show or are late for the AP exam will be required to pay \$40 for the unused exam fee.
10. I understand that I must report to my exam at least 30 minutes prior to the exam start time. Late arrivals will not be permitted to test, per College Board policy, and will be charged the \$40 unused exam fee.
