Technical Writing

Technical Writing is designed for students who wish to apply writing skills to technology and industry fields. Students will write assignments emphasizing techniques of précis/abstract, extended definition, comparison/contrast, problem solving, cause/effect and persuasion as applied to the work place. Assignments and activities will include the use of computers and internet research, and includes field research, group research projects, and group presentations.

Particular Topics in Psychology (Psych 2)

These courses examine a particular topic in psychology, such as human growth and development or personality, rather than provide a more comprehensive overview of the field. Subtopics include scientific methods in behavioral sciences, the brain, the nervous, the sensory organs, disorders, theories of personalities and therapies.

ENGLISH /LANGUAGE ARTS 1/HONORS 9TH (9TH GRADE HONORS ENGLISH)

NCES: 01001

Grade: 9

Semesters: Full Year

English/Language Arts 1/Honors 9th (9th Grade Honors English)

English/Language Arts 1 (9th grade) courses build upon students' prior knowledge of grammar, vocabulary, word usage, and the mechanics of writing and usually include the four aspects of language use: reading, writing, speaking and listening. Typically, these courses introduce and define various genres of literature, with writing exercises often linked to reading selections.
